PASSPORT RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM FILLING INSTRUCTIONS

(NORMAL)

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- All applications must be filled under **TORONTO**JURISDICTION.
- Form series should start with the current year (For Example: Year-2022, Series-22)
- Fee: Adult: \$103.40, Minor: \$72.40, 60 Pages: \$134.40
- Application type should be REISSUE; FRESH only in case of a baby born in Canada who has Indian Parents and wants to apply for Fresh Indian Passport.
- All Personal Particulars must be filled exactly as per Indian Passport or Supporting Documents, if any.
- Annexure E signed by applicant is required with all application forms with Canadian Address mentioned on it.
- For applicants born in India,
 - Citizenship of India should be by BIRTH
- For applicants born out of India,
 - Citizenship of India should be by DESCENT
- Passport Issue and Expiry date should be as per
 Passport, or observations on Passport (if any).

- For Lost or Damaged passport, service should be selected accordingly.
- All Questions on page 2 of the application form must be answered NO. If any YES, provide proof for the same.

NAME, APPEARANCE & SIGNATURES

- AKA / ALIAS are not accepted in any name on the Application form. Choose the Name Before, or After the ALIAS.
- For name change procedure, follow Checklist on BLS
 Website
- Prefix/Suffix is not acceptable with any name on the Application Form (For Example: SHRI, LATE, MR, MRS, ER, DR, MAJOR, SUBEDAR, SARDAR, COLONEL Etc.)
- For any Change in Appearance of the Applicant, provide Self Declaration on Plain paper for change of Appearance.
- Signatures should be there on first and last page of form EXACTLY as per passport. (Self Declaration on Plain paper required for any change in signatures).

CANADIAN STATUS

• Applicants should have Valid Canadian status. If the status has expired, IRCC letter for Status extension

should be provided along with the expired Canadian status and receipt copy.

- Applicants with PR must provide their COPR
 (Confirmation of PR) / Landing Papers document with visible Immigration Category.
- In Case the COPR is not available, provide either of the following:
 - Copy of Canadian Visa Stamp issued only from
 India on which the applicant entered Canada from
 India
 - Apply for Status verification document issued by IRCC or Canadian Refugee Board

ADDRESS

- Applicants have to mention both Printable & Other
 address on application form according to their Status
 in Canada.
- For Applicants on **Permanent Residence** (PR) Status,
 - "Printable Address" should be Canadian.
 - "Other Address" should be Indian.
- For Applicants on Study Permit, Work Permit, and
 Visitor Permit, there is an option for the address:
 - If "Printable address" is Canadian, "Other Address" should be Indian.
 - If "Printable Address" is Indian, "Other Address" should be Canadian.

• Acceptable Address Proofs:

- Government Issued Letters and ID's
- Driving Licence, Photo ID card, Health Card with Address mentioned on it
- Notice of Assessment issued by Canada Revenue
 Agency
- Home Utility Bills (Hydro, Electricity, Wi-Fi)
- PHONE BILLS, PAYSTUBS, VOID CHEQUE & DIRECT
 DEPOSIT FORMS, BANK STATEMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR MINOR APPLICANTS

- Annexure D with both parents' sign EXACTLY as per their passports is required.
- Annexure C is required only if:
 - Minor has Single parent/ One Parent has Deceased
 - Parents have Divorced/Separated
 - One Parent has Sole Custody of Minor
- In case of divorce granted in a foreign country and authorising the custody of the child/ren to a parent/guardian, an application must be submitted by the parties at the competent Indian civil court and a declaratory order authentication and confirming that the foreign divorce decree is in accordance with Indian law must be obtained by the concerned parties, before the mutual/contested foreign divorce is accepted by PIAs for grant of any passport service.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS FOR LOST / DAMAGED PASSPORT

- For Damaged Passport, Annexure F Required along with the fee for Damaged Passport Renewal- \$196.40
- For Lost Passport,
 - Annexure F with Lost Passport Fee- \$196.40
 - Police Occurrence Report with Applicant's name and Lost Passport Number Mentioned on it.

WHO CANNOT APPLY PASSPORT RENEWAL IN TATKAAL?

- Applicants with **Short Validity Passports**(Less than 10 Years for Adult and 5 years for child).
- Applicants with Lost passport.
- Applicants with Place of birth, Place of Issue, or Indian Address in Jammu, Kashmir, Srinagar (Anywhere in J&K) and Nagaland.
- Applicants with Change of Signatures or Appearance (not applicable to children).
- Applications with any corrections in Given Name,
 Surname, Parents' name, or Spouse Name.
- Applicants who want to ADD or DELETE Spouse Name.
- AKA or ALIAS on any Name in Passport.
- Applicants on Maintained or Applied Status, whose previous status has expired.
- 60 Pages Passport is not issued in Tatkaal.

NOTE: Minors above 15 Years of age will only get passport until 18 years of age under Tatkaal, and their application will be not accepted even if they pay Adult Tatkaal Fee.

Note: Hiding of marital status amounts to suppression of information and will be viewed seriously and will result in cancellation of passport.
